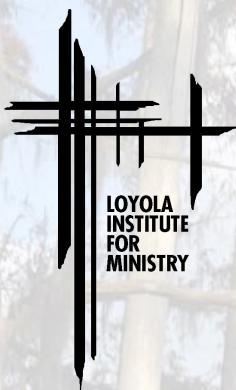

Master's Degree in Pastoral Studies (MPS) with a focus on Religion and Ecology

This degree emphasizes practical theology, a rhythm of action and theological reflection. It is grounded in the best of the Christian biblical and theological tradition and is guided by the conviction that we live in a sacred world. The 36 credit-hour program includes the courses

- *Celebrate the presence and activity of the divine in the natural world.*
- *Explore the revolutionary process as our comprehensive sacred story.*
- *Extend and revise traditional theological language.*
- *Integrate scientific knowledge of the natural world with Christian spirituality.*

The Universe as Divine Manifestation engages students in a process of discernment, interpretation, and response to the natural world as revelatory, as a primary mediation and distinctive focus of divine presence and activity.

The Emergent Universe: Our Sacred Story asks participants to immerse themselves in contemporary discoveries and understandings of the emergent universe and to reflect on its spiritual dimensions and significance.
