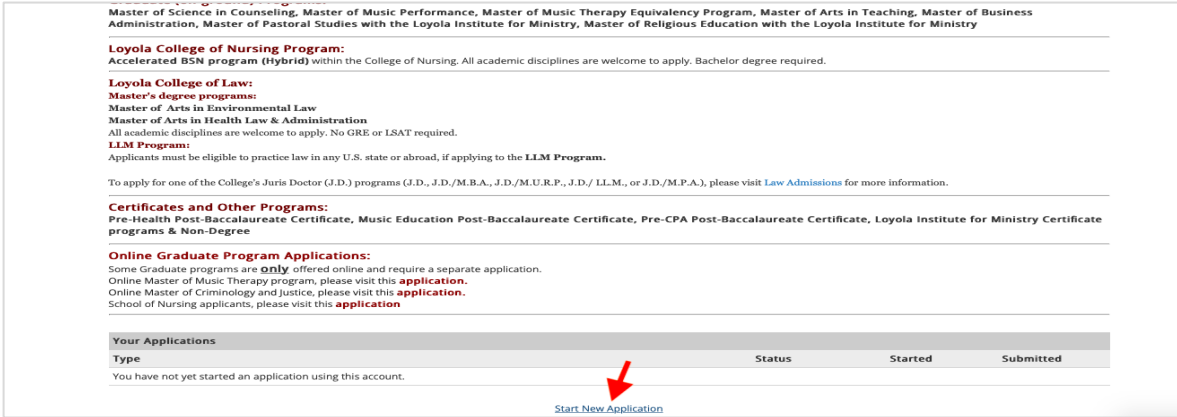
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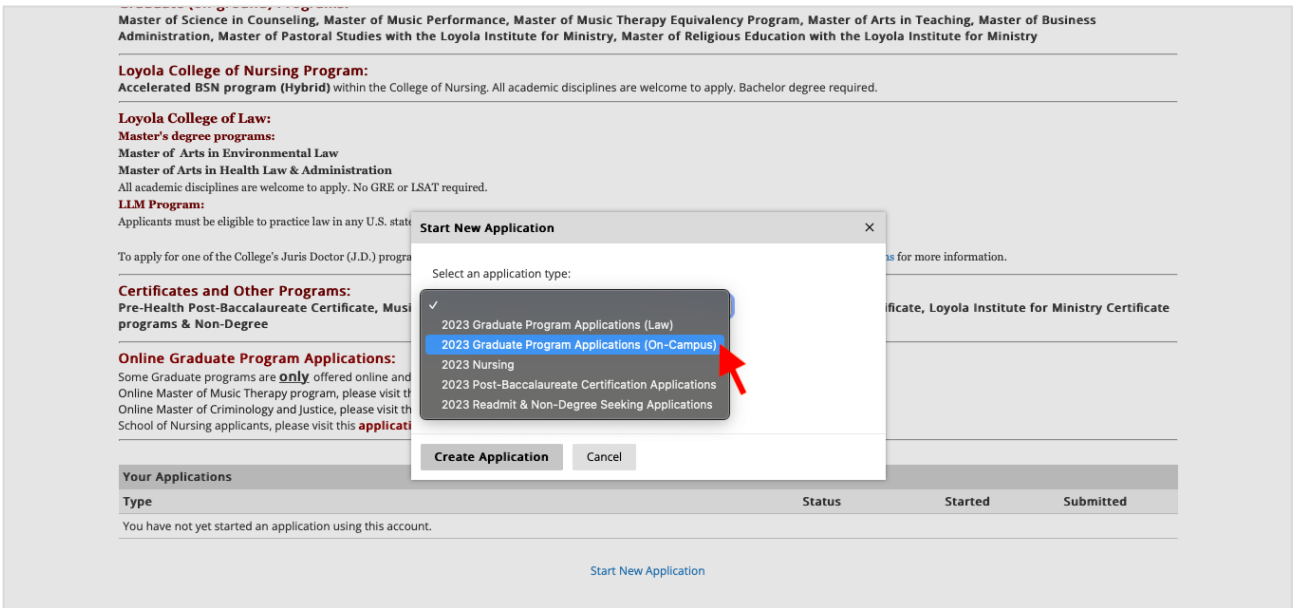

2 Recommendations Forms	These must be completed by professionals in ministry and/or education who can attest to your service/ministry involvement and readiness for graduate work. In the application, you will be asked to supply the contact information of the recommenders to which forms will be distributed. Please do not ask your recommenders to write a separate letter as we have specific questions for the recommenders.

The application asks for information that will allow us to assess your potential for achievement in our graduate programs. We do so without reference to race, sex, creed, or religious preference, and our holistic process is designed to select students with strong potential for success.

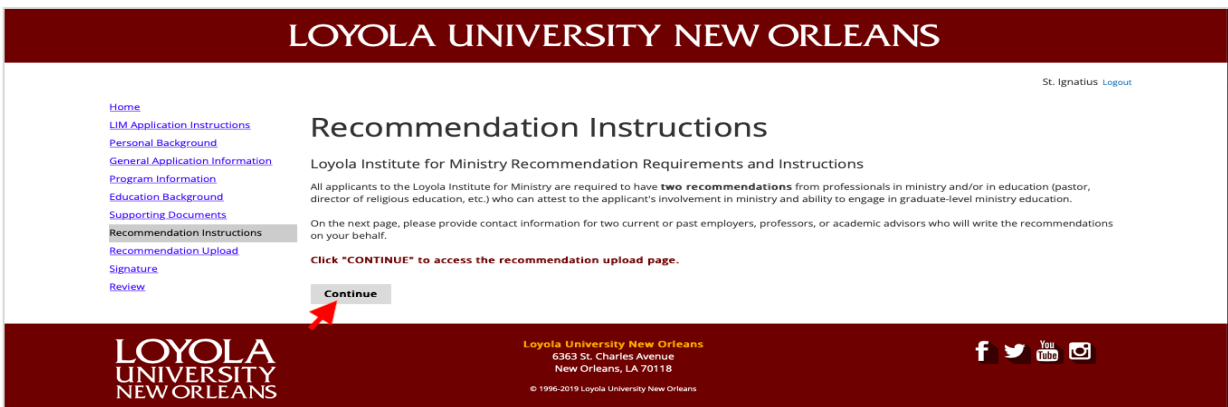
Step 12, Supporting Documents: Upload supporting documents by clicking on the “Choose File” buttons and selecting the appropriate file, then click “Upload.”
